Acknowledge receipt of the Addendum by inserting its number into the Bid Form. This addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents.

<u>Item No. 1</u> Clarification – Pre-Emergent Weed Control Frequency

Refer to the updated Exhibit A Maintenance Schedule for a correction to the number of services to provide. The former schedule denoted four treatments in March and April and again in September and October. This has been updated to occur once in Spring and Fall in either of the months mentioned above. Refer to Exhibit B for updated bid sheets that reflect this change.

Item No. 2 Impact of Construction on Pearland Parkway

There will be no impact to plantings. however, irrigation along the southbound west side ROW will be modified because of the project.

<u>Item No. 3</u> Pre-Emergent vs. Overseed Turf Frequency and Timing

Line items 11 and 20 are now combined to create an either/or option based on the contractor's expertise as to whether to overseed in Spring and use pre-emergent in the Fall or vice versa, depending on soil and turf conditions. Refer to the updated Exhibit A Maintenance Schedule and updated Exhibit B for bid sheets that reflect this change.

Item No. 4 Seasonal Color Quantity

The quantity for line item #12 in the bid sheets has been updated from 1 EA to 500 SF in each area.

<u>Item No. 5</u> Clarify the type of grass for overseeding

A. Spring/Summer Planting:

(April 15 to Sept. 15)

Hulled Bermuda 2 lbs./1000 Sq. Ft.

B. Fall/Winter Planting:

(Sept. 15 to April 15)

Unhulled Bermuda 1 ½ lbs./1000 Sq. Ft. KY Fesque 5 lbs./1000 Sq. Ft.

C. St. Augustine cannot be overseeded. Any damage or repairs needed shall be solid sod.



GATEWAY SIGNAGE LOCATION MAP





Fig 2.2 This map highlights the locations of proposed Gateway Signage compared to existing signage locations. Gateways would be scheduled to occur in phases over time.








- Follow our schedule
- Follow the Spec to the letter (because we will)
- Take note that there is going to be a repairs allowance and we expect some small repairs to be made immediately – such as small rut repair, drip leaks and unclogging of nozzles and other equipment within the allotted (internally set) budget.
- Check all equipment is working and in good condition including Cityissued locks for gates and the irrigation system.

Reporting & Communication

Reports & Meetings

- Submit Reports Monthly with the Invoice
 - Irrigation Report
 - Chemical Report
 - Materials Report
- Monthly Services Performed Report
 - See Exhibit F for needed elements
 - Include Observations of other project elements such as lighting/electrical problems, ruts, areas in need of power washing, etc.
- Monthly Virtual Progress Meetings with Owner
- Quarterly Onsite Inspections with Owner
- Annual Irrigation Test with Owner
- Other meetings as needed, such as if construction coordination in the project area is needed or the contractor needs more direction, or wants to make changes to the annual plan for maintenance submitted in the bid.

Communicate

PEDC must be notified:

- In advance of all services (contracted and proposal related) date and, if possible, what time crews are scheduled to be onsite.
- Prior to application of herbicides and insecticides. Owner prefers, when possible, to have someone present for chemical applications.
- When plant material is dying off or other components are not working as witnessed during monthly services.
- When damaged landscape or ruts are discovered - as quickly as feasibly possible, especially in regard to car damage. Photos of impacted areas submitted with any and all proposals or other damage reports are helpful.

Maps and Diagrams

- Every stretch of area has a corresponding diagram.
- As other contractors are often in the area, review the City's interactive map to ensure you are servicing only the areas you are supposed to.
